Flu and Covid Jabs

It's that time of year again where we encourage all our eligible patients to have their flu vaccination. This year, we can also offer the Covid booster to certain patient groups. Please attend the clinics when you are invited to do so or book with a local chemist. If you are eligible for free NHS vaccinations, most high street chemists can also administer your jabs if you prefer.

Cancer Screening

We cannot encourage you enough to take up any invitations of cancer screening that you may be offered. In particular cervical screening (smear tests) and FIT (the poo test) can detect early or pre cancer changes. Early detection makes all the difference. If you don't want to do it for yourself, do it for your loved ones.
